










End users are now required to explicitly accept the *Terms and Conditions* before proceeding with payment.





New features


- New User Interface
 - The user interface (used for web printing, web payment, and accessing user information) has been completely redesigned for a more modern and intuitive experience.
 - Available features include:
 - User login
 - Login using either a username and password or a print code
 - The central logo on the login page can be customized with a customer logo.



- Account creation
 - Users can create accounts (if enabled) and reset passwords via email.
 - When a new account is created, a welcome email can be sent (if configured in Gespage notification tasks).
- User interface menu
 - Upon login, the following menus are available:



- Dashboard menu
 - Displays a summary of user activity and news:
 - Environmental impact
 - Account details
 - o Job distribution
 - Job activity trends
 - News panel (customizable for internal communication)




Print menu (web printing)

 This allows users to submit documents for printing via the 'Add Docs' button.



 Supports the standard Gespage mobile printing document formats.


- The destination printer is set to the default mobile printer, but users can change it via autocomplete.
- Pending jobs are listed with their printing details. Additional information can be viewed by clicking the eye icon.
 - Users can delete pending documents from this menu.



- History menu
 - Displays the user's print job and credit history.




- Web payment (optional)
 - The 'Add credit' menu allows users to top up their account through a payment gateway
 - Worldline integration
 - o Worldline integration now uses the Worldline Direct API.
 - The payment receipt is sent to the user by email
 - This feature requires the Gespage web payment license




- Multilingual support
 - The interface is displayed in the browser's language. If a translation is not available, it defaults to English.
- Configuration
 - As part of the User Interface redesign, configuration parameters have been streamlined for easier administration. Refer to the Gespage Administration Manual for details.





Gespage Advanced Scan

- Scan to SharePoint Online directories
 - Added support for the SharePoint storage connector
 - It is now possible to configure scan destinations to SharePoint document libraries
 - As with Gespage advanced scan features, these destinations can be dynamically offered based on the user
 - This requires users to be synchronized through Entra ID



Scan to Google Drive (Pro)

- Added support for Google Drive storage
 - It is now possible to configure a Gespage advanced scan destination towards the user's professional Google Drive account.
 - Scanned documents are saved in the user's personal Drive space.
 - This requires users to be synchronized through Google Cloud Directory (Google Workspace).
- Scan to SMB directories
 - Add support for protocol SMB v3
- User Directory Synchronization
 - Google Cloud Directory synchronization
 - Google Cloud Directory refers to the directory service used by Google Workspace.
 - You can now synchronize your Gespage users from a Google Cloud Directory.
 - Entra ID synchronization
 - Various advanced synchronization settings are now available

- User synchronization can now be filtered based on a specified group list
- o It is now possible to define an initial **color quota** upon a user's first creation.

Upgrade information

- User interface
 - Due to many changes in the user interface configuration, it is required to fully review the user interface configuration after the upgrade.
 - For On Premise installation, the user interface port is changed to 7143 after the upgrade.
- Web payment
 - The Worldline setup must be updated to align with the new integration mode.
- Xerov eTerminal
 - o Each Xerox eTerminal must be pushed again after the Gespage 9.3.0 upgrade.
- System
 - o PostgreSQL upgrade requires the database reinstallation.

Limitations

 - Login through SSO (with a CAS server) is not yet available
 - Web payment: PayPal support is not yet available

 - o Access rights management is not yet available.




 Gespage home menu for quick access to core functions: PRINT, SCAN and COPY





Improved environmental dashboard tile

- The environmental calculation formulas can now be configured via the Server / Report configuration menu.
- Added new Savings reports.
 - These reports are available through the Reports / Savings menu and can be subscribed to for email reception.
 - Reports can be filtered by users, printers, departments or billing codes and are exportable in PDF or CSV format.



- Gespage Advanced Scan
 - Scan to Microsoft OneDrive
 - New integration with Microsoft OneDrive Business allows easy setup of Gespage scan to OneDrive.
 - A scan destination with the outgoing destination to Microsoft OneDrive Business must be created under Gespage administration menu to enable this scan destination.



 The user's OneDrive destination is then automatically added to the eTerminal Gespage scan destinations.



This feature is only available for users synchronized from Entra ID.


- Microsoft Universal Print support
 - Gespage 9 is now compatible with Microsoft Universal Print (MUP).
 - The configuration of the Universal Print printers must be done in the Azure portal.
 - The print2me printer must be installed on the local network and requires installation of the Universal Print connector and Gespage MUP agent.
 - The Universal Print integration must be set up in Gespage configuration menus





- American paper sizes


- New improved support for US paper sizes through the new parameter 'Default paper size format'.
 - In US mode, default paper sizes are Letter and Legal
 - In EU mode, default paper sizes are A4 and A3




This impacts the price menus, the mobile user interface, and reporting formats.



- Gespage Pay Station (GPayStation v9.2.0)
 - Gespage 9 is now compatible with the GPayStation application.
 - The GPayStation client application provides release station functionality in public environments from a dedicated workstation.
 - GPayStation usage
 - Selecting jobs to be paid:
 - In authenticated mode, the users must authenticate to access their pending jobs.
 - In guest mode, the entire pending job list is displayed once the 'Click to print' button is pressed.
 - Paying jobs to be released:
 - Payment is possible through a Cartadis magnetic purse card.
 - GPayStation configuration
 - The new GPayStation Station ID field has now to be set up in the GPayStation client and in its Gespage configuration, to uniquely identify the GPayStation instance.
 - o The GPayStation application requires Java 11 installation on the workstation.



- Administration tools
 - New tool to download Gespage logs and configuration files is accessible from Support / Tools / Downloading logs. Either all logs or an advanced selection of log files can be selected for download.
